**LINWOOD COMMUNITY/SCHOOL FOREST MEDALLION HUNT RULES**

**MEDALLION HUNT BEGINS MONDAY, FEBRUARY 20TH**

1. The Medallion is hidden on the Linwood Community Park and School Forest Property. The Medallion can be found without damaging, defacing or otherwise destroying any property. There is no need to trespass on private property. No digging tools are required to find the Medallion but are allowed. The Medallion is easily identified upon finding.
2. Everyone is eligible to hunt for the Medallion. There is no entry fee of any kind. The only one to know the whereabouts of the Medallion will be Mr. Martin, Linwood School Principal. He has hidden the Medallion and has written the clues that will help participants find its location. Read the clues carefully.
3. To get your clues you can go to Linwood Town Hall or Linwood Elementary School each day beginning Monday, February 20<sup>th</sup> at 7:45 a.m. Clues will be posted at these two locations throughout the Medallion Hunt. The Medallion Hunt is scheduled to run from Monday, February 20th until the Medallion is found. Clues will be posted accordingly.
4. To claim the prizes associated with the Medallion Hunt, the finder must take the Medallion to Linwood Town Hall and present it for proof of identification. Town Hall is not open on weekends so verification must be done on Monday morning. Prizes will be awarded to the finder pending proof of authenticity. A list of prizes is available at the Town Hall and Linwood Elementary School. Finder agrees to allow their name and/or photo to be used for the local press and news releases and in future promotion/publicity of the School Forest and activities.
